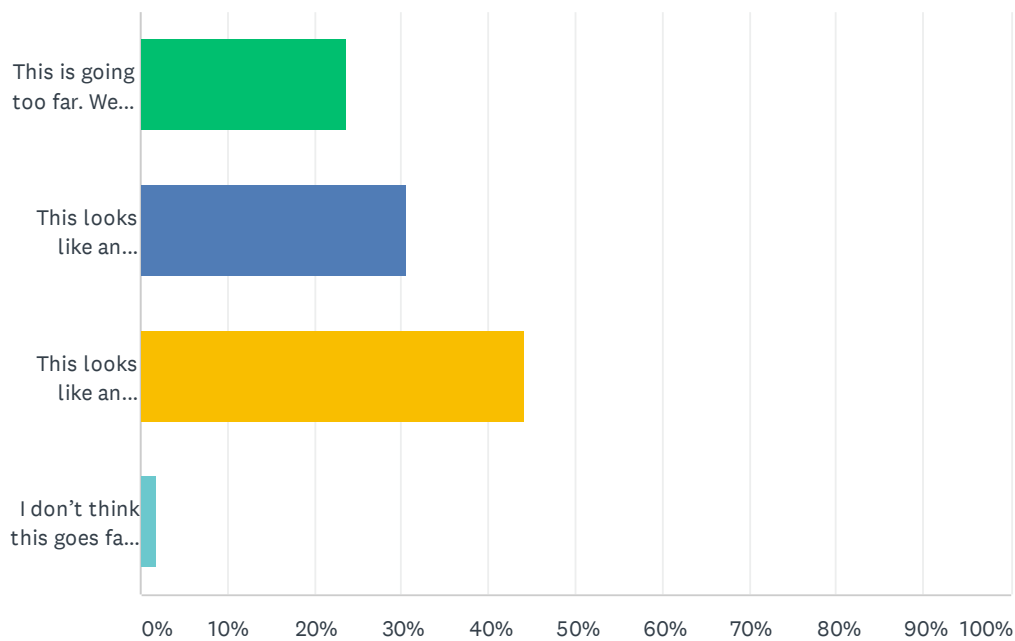

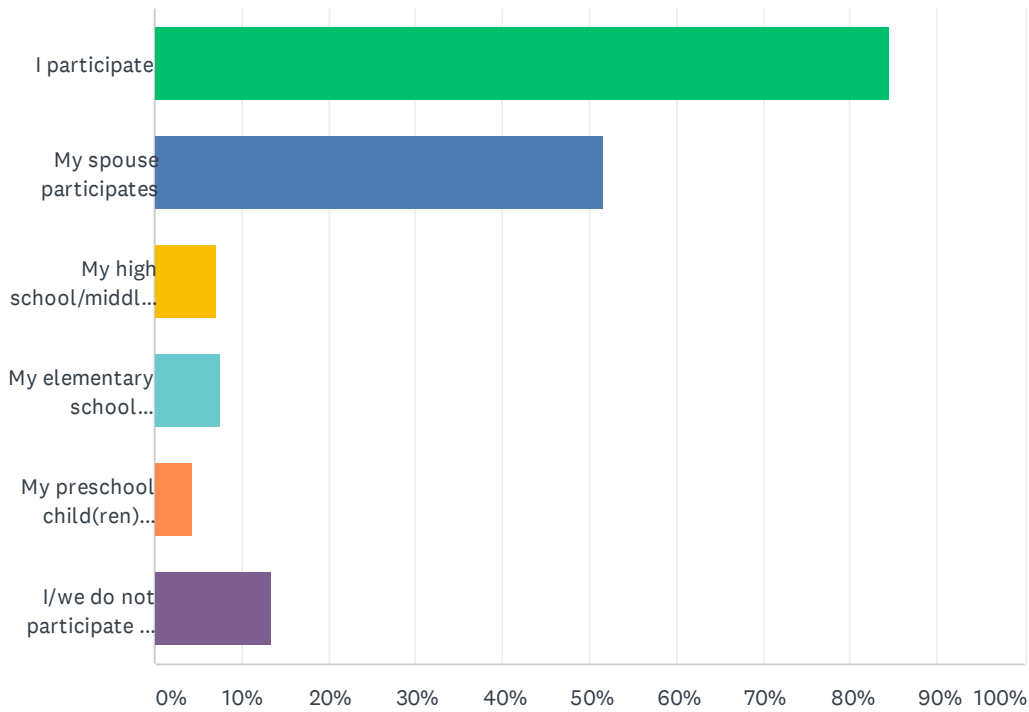

Q2 Who in your household regularly or occasionally participates in the online worship services? (check all that apply)

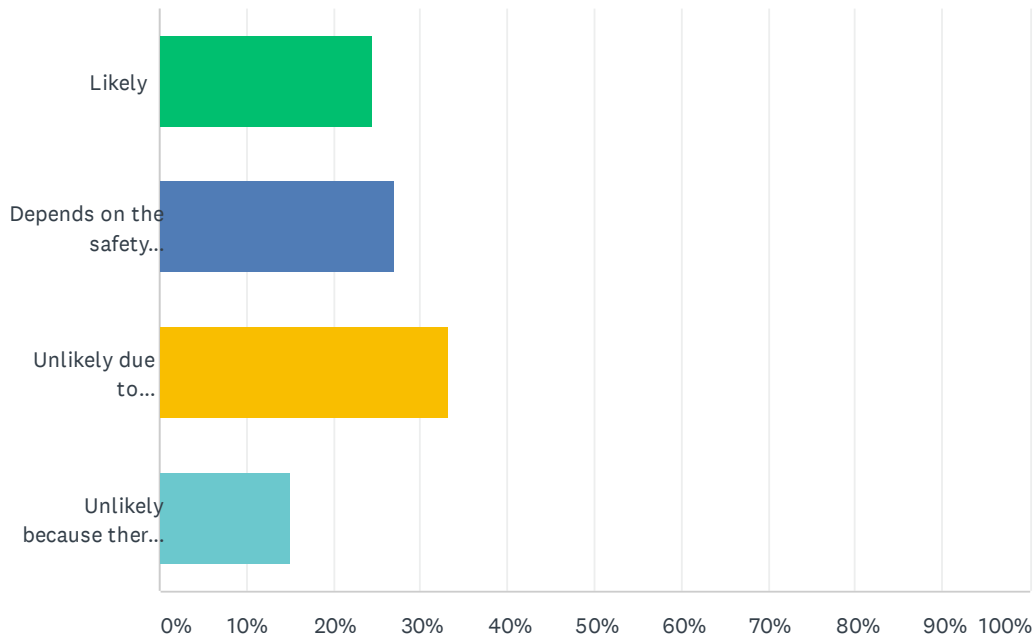

Q3 If we begin offering in-person worship in June, how likely is it that you would attend?

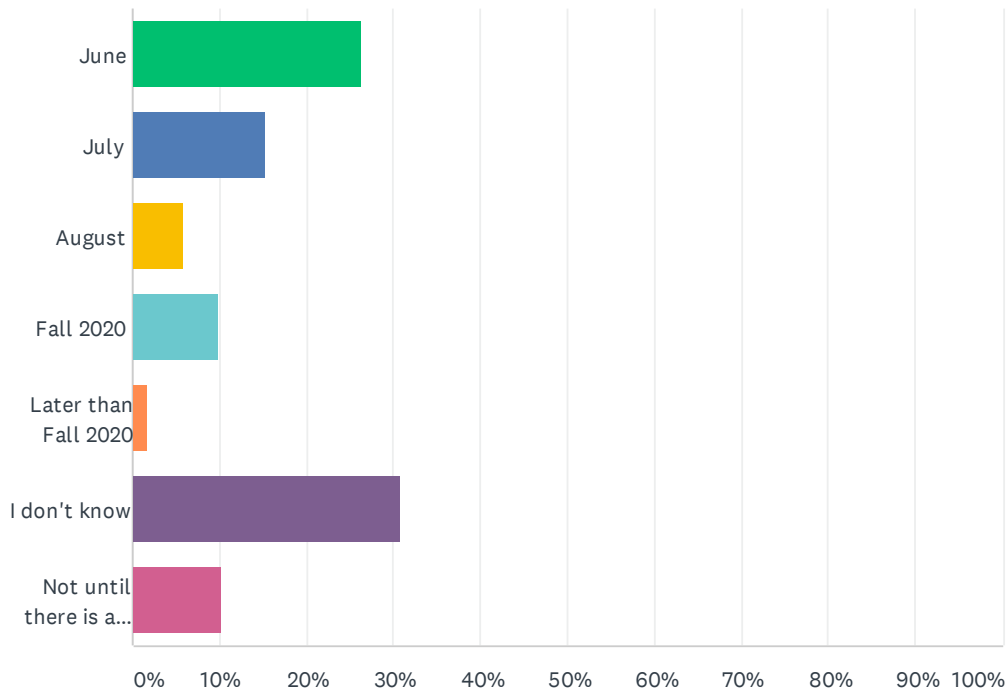

Q4 Based on what you know today, when would you be ready to return to CCUM for in-person worship?

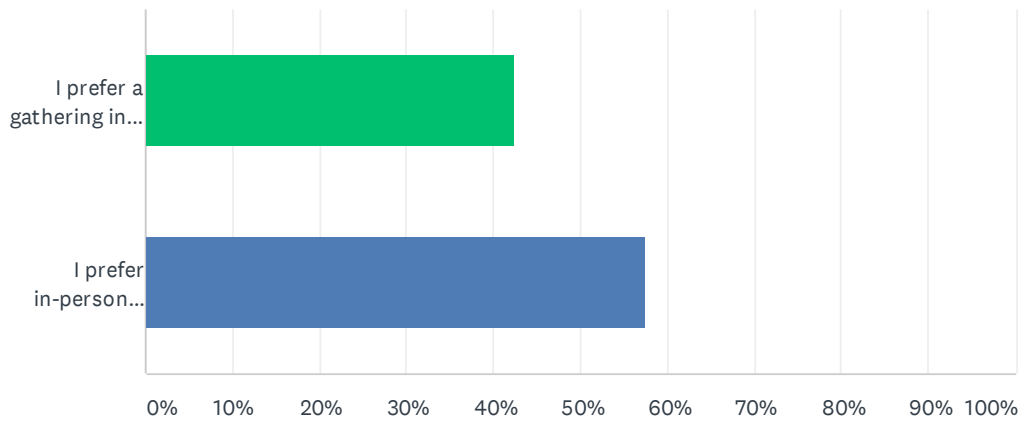

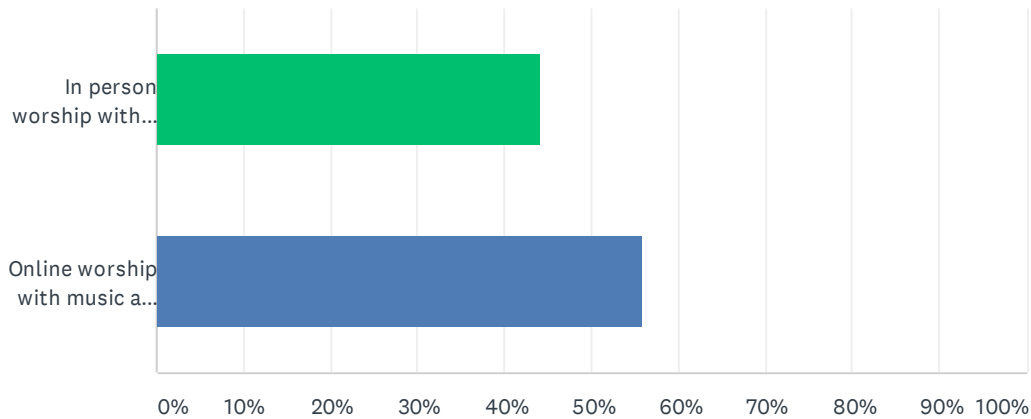

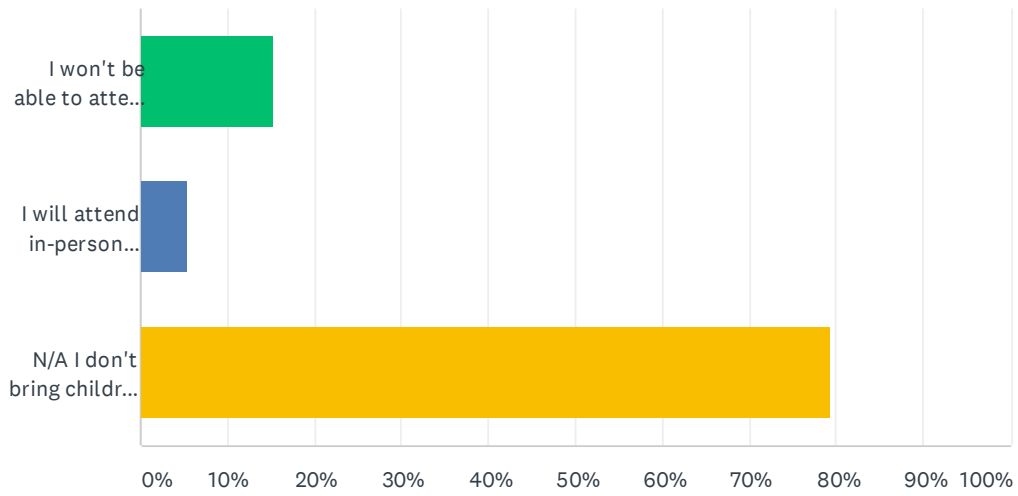

Q7 In the initial phase, if you can't bring children under age 10 to church, how will it affect your decision to attend?

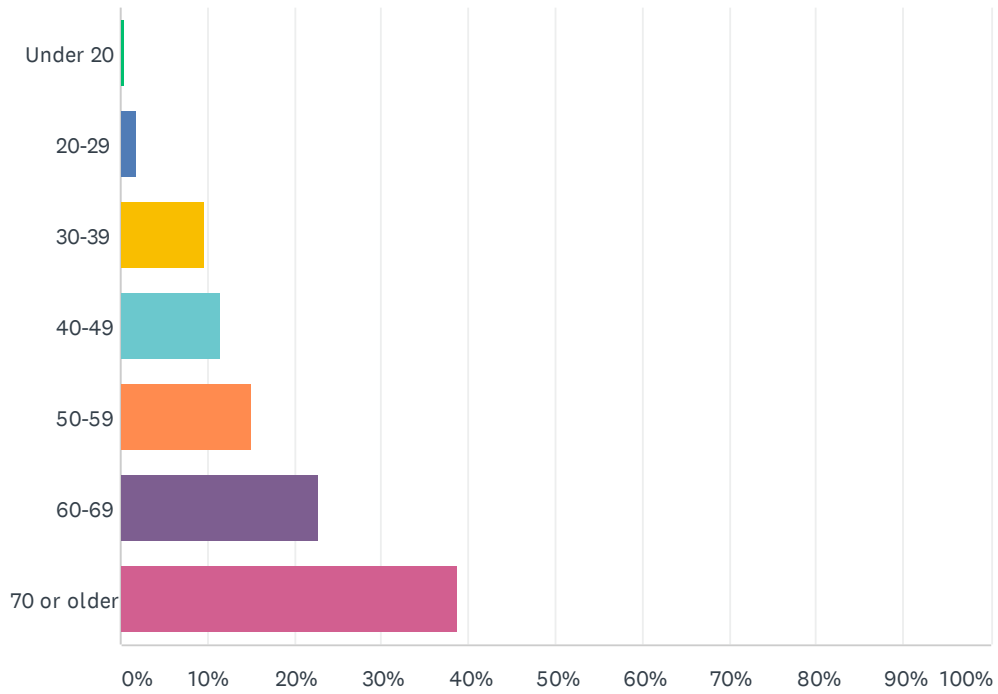

Q8 What is your age?

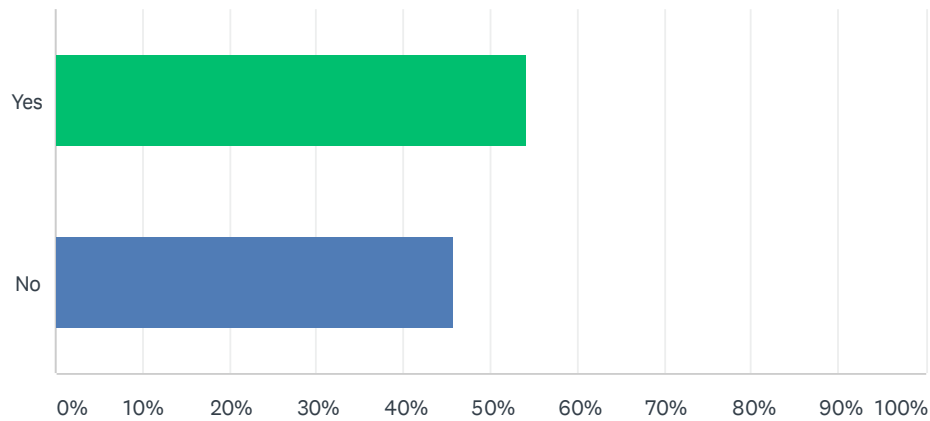
