## Lesson 1: The Wesleyan Quadrilateral

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### STUDY GUIDE

1. What do you turn to scripture for? Guidance, comfort, study, insight, etc.?

Read Psalm 119:105 and 2 Timothy 3:14-17

2. Has there ever been a time in your life, times of struggle or crisis, where you have turned to the Bible for insight, comfort or strength? What do you think God did with you in the midst of that time?
3. What are some of your favorite traditions in church? Why are they so meaningful to you? Are there any traditions that you think need to be put away?
4. How might the three supporting sources for scripture: Tradition, Reason and Experience, help you understand the Bible?
5. In the video, Pastor Eric mentioned the three-fold understanding of Grace, as Prevenient, Justifying, and Sanctifying. Can you find yourself in this understanding of Grace? How does this enhance your understanding of the Bible and finding your place in God's story?

6. Have you ever thought of scripture as useful for 'training in righteousness'? Consider how you might have trained for anything, an athletic event, a job or career, parenting, etc. How is scripture useful for you in "training for righteousness?"
