



The wedding ceremony is a sacred and important service of worship. With this consideration foremost in mind, Christ Church has adopted the following policies relating to photography of weddings:

1. Upon your arrival at the church, the Coordinator will inform you as to the area that the bride has chosen for pre-wedding photographs. In addition, you may take unlimited outdoor photos if weather permits.
2. Pre-wedding photos may begin 2 hours before the ceremony. We ask that you finish 60 minutes before the scheduled time for the ceremony. This gives the wedding party time to regroup and seat guests who arrive early. This also allows you and your assistant time to move into position to photograph the processional and ceremony.
3. The professional photographer may take one picture of each member of the wedding party as they process down the aisle no further down the aisle than six rows from the back. No flash photos may be taken once the party reaches the chancel area. You may take unlimited non-flash pictures from the balcony.
4. Photographers should be appropriately attired for the wedding.
